

Camp Invention is a non-profit program of the National Inventors Hall of Fame Foundation and receives support from the US Patent and Trademark office. The one-week summer enrichment program is hosted in local schools and led by certified teachers. The program fosters creativity, science literacy, problem solving and inventive-thinking skills. Hands-on, inquiry based learning is emphasized in integrated curricula that aligns with national and state education standards. Children learn through teamwork, subject immersion, and open-ended discovery.
